

RULES & REGULATIONS



GENERAL

1. By signing up to Padma Run Semarang 2024 (Race), participants have agreed to fully comply with its Rules & Regulations.
2. Padma Run Semarang 2024 is available in two race categories: 10K dan 5K.
3. Participants who are under 17 years of age on September 24, 2023 (race day) must obtain parental/guardian consent by the time of participation. Padma Hotel Semarang reserves the right to deny access to applicants who do not meet the age requirement.
4. The podium prizes for Padma Run Semarang 2024 will be awarded to the winners in the Men's category and the Women's category.
5. All participants are advised to seek medical advice from a doctor regarding their health condition before participating in the Race. Participants shall acknowledge and accept that their participation in the Race carries potential risks and hazards, including, but not limited to, accidents, physical injuries, health issues, paralysis, death, property damage, and/or other losses, as well as other unknown and currently unforeseeable risks ("Risks and Hazards"). Risks and Hazards may occur due to, among other things, the actions or omissions of the Participants or the actions or omissions of others, and/or the conditions of the facilities and/or equipment, and natural and/or weather conditions, and/or Force Majeure conditions (as defined below).
6. The organizers of Padma Run Semarang 2024 and Padma Hotel Semarang ("Competition Organizers") shall not be liable for any dangers and/or losses caused by the following, including, but not limited to:
 - a. Risk and Danger Occurrence;
 - b. Arriving late to the Competition;
 - c. Pre-existing illnesses;
 - d. Accidents during participation in the competition and/or;
 - e. Loss and/or damage to personal property during participation in the competition.

7. The copyright and other intellectual property rights (if any) of images, photos, articles, timing records, and location covering Padma Run Semarang 2024, and their usage rights for television broadcasts, newspapers, magazines, the internet, and other media or publications are owned by the organizers. Such usage also includes, but not limited to, the names and other personal information such as age and address (country, province, and city) of Participants.
8. Participants must be able to complete the entire distance required for their race category, from the official starting line to the official finishing line, within the time specified by the Competition Organizers (Cut Off Time and Cut Off Point). Please note that the calculation of official timing records is at the discretion of the Competition Organizers.
9. Participants who do not meet the Cut Off Time and participants who are disqualified are considered as participants who did not complete the race and would not be entitled to receive finisher medals.
10. The BIB number is a unique personal identification for the Participant and cannot be exchanged and/or transferred.
11. The sale and/or transfer of Race entries/BIB numbers are prohibited, and any violation results in disqualification and/or prohibition of the individuals involved from participating in future events.
12. The BIB number must be clearly visible during the race. Organizers have the authority to withhold the BIB number and race pack under certain conditions such as violations of the Rules & Regulations, indications of forgery, and/or similar conditions.
13. Registration fees are non-refundable. The Competition Organizers reserve the right to reject registrations that have been confirmed if there is false, fake, and/or incomplete information in the registration form.
14. Participants are required to regularly review the Rules & Regulations every time they access or use the official website or application of Padma Hotel Semarang, as the Competition Organizers may change the Rules & Regulations in accordance with our policy without prior notice.
15. Additional conditions that are not yet listed in these Rules & Regulations may be determined later by the Competition Organizers.

RULES & REGULATIONS



RACE DAY

1. Participants are required to enter the starting line and start according to the specified time, which is at 5AM (GMT +07:00). Late participation will result in disqualification from the Padma Run Semarang 2024 event.
2. Run without disrupting other participants, give way to faster runners, and do not stop in the middle of the Padma Run Semarang 2024 route.
3. Participants engaging in unsportsmanlike behavior, including, but not limited to, blocking and/or obstructing other Participants along the run course, will be automatically disqualified from the Race.
4. Signage and kilometer markers are present along the race route; please follow the installed road markers.
5. The committee provides official photographers at the Start/Finish line, as well as along the race route.
6. Dispose of trash properly. Trash bins are available at the race village and water station points.
7. Runners are asked to maintain their hydration during the race.
8. Timing records are provided for each category. All Participants will be given a BIB number with a timing chip to wear during the Race. Checkpoints will be placed at the start/finish line, and at designated timing points to ensure all Participants follow the official race course. Participants who fail to follow the official race course will be disqualified from Padma Run Semarang 2024.
9. If a Participant decides to stop running along the Padma Run Semarang 2024 route for any reason, inform the nearest marshal, then return to the Start/Finish area by following the marshal's guidance and joining the Ambulance provided by the Organizers
10. The committee provides 2 units of Ambulance. The first Ambulance is accessible at the race village of Padma Hotel Semarang and the second is ready at the end of the participants' track along the Padma Run Semarang 2024 route.

RULES & REGULATIONS



POTENTIAL WINNERS

1. The winning participant ("Winner") must wear the timing chip and associated BIB number. Winners must provide identification to claim their prizes. Winners who cannot provide valid identification may be disqualified and forfeit their prizes.
2. Potential Winners must immediately undergo verification at the verification tent, right after crossing the finish line.
3. Verification process is only valid immediately after receiving the verification lanyard.
4. Potential Winners who fail to verify within 30 minutes after finishing and receiving the verification lanyard are considered to have withdrawn as potential winners and are not eligible to make claims later or in the future.
5. There will be no other verifications apart from those specified above.
6. Please note that cash prizes are taxable items according to government regulations, which are fully borne by the winners.
